



Luiss Alumni Scholarships for refugees

Since 2019 Luiss University enriched its Global Engagement Strategy promoting the **human capital** of young refugees and offering the possibility to study in Luiss University for refugees coming from African countries.

ALL and **Luiss** are offering **1 scholarship** for the 2020/2021 academic year for **master degree programs** taught in English, open to refugee students – UNHCR registered – in **Ethiopia**.

The program envisages the award of a full-ride scholarship to each admitted student, covering tuition fees and the total cost of bed and board in Rome during the 2 academic years.

To finalize the application candidates must fill out the [application form online](#) by **4 June 2020**, attaching an **academic transcript** (language certifications, SAT and ACT are optional). Luiss University will ask for a **letter of reference** to the Professor mentioned by the applicant in the application form.

In their application, candidates are required to indicate in the first line of their motivation letter the **Ration Card Number of their Proof of Registration** or the number of the **Refugee Identity card** issued by Ethiopian authorities in collaboration with UNHCR.

Candidates are required to upload the following documents under the section “Other Qualifications” of the application form:

- the scanned copy of their **Ration Card Number of their Proof of Registration**
or
- the scanned copy of their currently valid **Refugee Identity card** issued by Ethiopian authorities in collaboration with UNHCR.

Application forms lacking of the above-mentioned documentation will be considered **incomplete**.

The results will be communicated by email to those applicants who will be selected.

The scholarship will be confirmed for the following academic year on condition that the student, by **31 July of every year**, has earned at least **70% of the education credits** required under their study plan.
