



**University Corridors for Refugees - UNICORE 3.0 (Ethiopia - 2021-2023)**

Call for applications for 3 study grants and welcome services for refugee students registering to second cycle degree programmes taught in English at the University of Milan, for the Academic Year 2021-2022

DEADLINES OF APPLICATION: 1<sup>st</sup> March 2021 - 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021

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INTRODUCTION

By Rectoral Decree number **972/2021** of 26 February 2021 it is approved the Call of Application: **University Corridors for Refugees - UNICORE 3.0 (Ethiopia 2021-2023)**

## **ART. 1 Subject, amount and duration.**

The general objective of the University Corridors for Refugees - UNICORE 3.0 project is to promote the right to high education for refugees through study corridors from Ethiopia to Italy. The project is jointly promoted by a consortium of partners:

United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR)

Caritas Italiana

Diaconia Valdese

Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MAECI)

The Italian Universities better specified in the Cooperation Agreement.

The commitment of the University of Milan to the project UNICORE 3.0 has been formalized with the signature of the National Cooperation Agreement, registered with Rectoral Decree nr. 238/2020 of 11<sup>th</sup> September 2020. The commitment for UNICORE 3.0 is conditional to the renewal of the Cooperation agreement for the years 2021-2023. The benefits are intended for refugees living in Ethiopia and admitted in a programme among those better specified in Article 1.1.

UNICORE 3.0 benefits are assigned for A.Y. 2021-22 and A.Y. 2022-23. Maintenance merit requirements and additional renewals conditions are listed in Art. 10.

## ART. 2 Local Partners of the Project

University of Milan will be supported in the project by two local partners: Caritas Ambrosiana and Diaconia Valdese. The support is conditional to the renewal of the cooperation agreement that for a.y. 20-21 has been formalized by rectoral decree 238/2020 of 11/09/2020.

### 2.1 Benefits and supports offered to the winners

Benefits included in the scholarship to all the winners will be the following:

- Full coverage of the expenses to be faced before the arrival in Italy: flight tickets, Visa and preparation of supporting documents (CARITAS)
- € 3,000 per year of study. Payments will be divided in bimestrial installments (e.g. paid each two months) and **subject to the achievement of merit requirements (see art. 10)**. Winners will be provided with more information upon enrollment. (UNIVERSITY OF MILAN)
- Free accommodation in one of our student dorms or student apartment in a **shared room** from October 2021 (UNIVERSITY OF MILAN)
- Meal card with two free meals a day from Monday to Saturday in our student canteen or affiliated restaurant (UNIVERSITY OF MILAN)
- Enrollment in NHS (CARITAS AMBROSIANA)
- A personal Pc (CARITAS AMBROSIANA)
- Additional monthly allowance up to € 100 for each student (24 months) which will cover meals not included in the meal card, personal hygiene expenses and the monthly mobile subscription (DIACONIA VALDESE)



- Coverage of the administrative expenses for the issuing of the permit to stay for study reason (DIACONIA VALDESE)
- Coverage of the administrative expenses for the renewal of the permit to stay for study (DIACONIA VALDESE)
- Support for the bureaucratic procedure and for the access to local services (DIACONIA VALDESE)
- Mobile SIM card and first month of subscription (DIACONIA VALDESE)
- A psychological support through an affiliated partner where needed (DIACONIA VALDESE)
- Guidance to the local and extra-academic services (DIACONIA VALDESE)
- Search for a matching family for opportunities of meeting and socialization (CARITAS AMBROSIANA)
- Italian Course organized by the language center of the University of Milan, SLAM
- Local students will support the winner in the integration in the student life and will assist for any bureaucratic problem met during the studies (UNIVERSITY OF MILAN)

The staff of the International student office of UNIMI together with local students will be at the student's disposal for assistance in any bureaucratic step of the project.

### **ART.3 Incompatibility.**

The UNICORE 3.0 study grants cannot be combined with:

- merit-based study grants/prizes issued by the University of Milan for the support of international students;
- study grants issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MAECI);
- CRUI grants for beneficiaries of international protection;
- study grants issued by foreign governmental bodies or institutions, on the basis of agreements with the University of Milan, aimed at assisting the enrolment of international students at the University of Milan;
- Regional scholarship offered by Lombardy region (DSU);

### **ART.4 Admission requirements.**

Application is open exclusively to candidates who meet the following requirements:



1. Reside in Ethiopia and have been recognized the refugee status in collaboration with UNHCR
2. Hold a qualification valid for admission to the chosen Second Cycle Degree Programme. The qualification must have been issued by an higher education institution accredited in the higher education system of the Country where the degree has been issued. The qualification must as well consent the access to a second level degree course in the country of issuance.
3. Hold a qualification not being obtained before the year 2016
4. Have a grade average of at least 24/30 - referred to the Italian System. For the conversion of the average to the Italian grading system it will be used the official conversion formula of the Italian Ministry of Education, as for attachment 2 of this call
5. Meet the specific admission requirements of the Second cycle degree program of interest

Moreover, the candidate needs to have never been enrolled in a degree programs at UNIMI or at any of the Partner University

## **ART.5 Selection criteria and application documents**

Students are selected on the basis of merit requirements: Grade Average, evaluation of the academic path compared with the programme of application, curriculum vitae and working experience.

The evaluation will be carried out by a Committee of Experts composed by Professor Alessia Di Pascale (Teaching staff in charge of the project), a member of the International Student office of UNIMI, the Professor in charge of the Master Programmes concerned - or her/his delegates - and any other relevant teaching staff or third party designated by the University of Milan or the relevant Professors Board.

Students are required to submit the following documentation:

### **MANDATORY DOCUMENTS:**

1. A copy of their currently valid Refugee Identity card issued in collaboration with UNHCR
2. A certificate confirming the qualification required for admission to the chosen degree programme
3. Transcripts of exams passed and relative marks
4. Curriculum Vitae - please follow the format in attachment 1



5. Any relevant and additional document required by the specific programmes chosen

#### NOT MANDATORY DOCUMENTS:

6. A motivation letter (maximum two A4 pages)
7. Letter/s of references written by supervisor/advisor supporting the application
8. Applicants are recommended to shoot a short video CV (e.g. using mobile phone) where they introduce themselves and their motivations. Examples on how to create a video CV can be found in Google.com.

In this phase, any translation of documents edited in languages other than English, Spanish, German, French or Italian can be done directly by the candidates.

#### **ART.6 Deadlines and modalities of application**

Applications are opened from 1<sup>st</sup> March 2021 at 12 pm (noon, UTC+1) to 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021 at 12:00 pm (noon, UTC+1).

Students are required to send all the documents needed for application using the online form available at this link:

Once the application will be successfully sent the candidate will receive a receipt in the email indicated in the on-line application form.

In order to apply candidate must register on the website: [www.unimi.it](http://www.unimi.it)

NOTE: the on-line form will be available only in during the application period.

Incomplete application will not be considered.

Students can apply only for one programme.

It is possible to apply for a maximum of two different university.

#### **ART.7 Selection process and establishment of the ranking**

The selection process is divided into two steps:

- Step 1: evaluation of the documentation
- Step 2: on-line interview

##### **7.1 Step 1 Evaluation of the documentation**

The Committee of Experts will evaluate the documentation according to the following criteria:

- Academic background and GPA (score: 0-15)



- Evaluation of CV: education, professional experience, language, and personal skills (score: 0-15)
- Coherence between previous studies and selected Second Cycle Degree programme (score: 0-10)

At the end of the first step it will be published a partial ranking **and only the first 15 candidates will be admitted to step 2**. For equal points, preference will be given to the younger candidate.

Candidates admitted to Step 2 will be notified by email by 30<sup>th</sup> April 2021, and the partial ranking will be published on the website [www.unimi.it](http://www.unimi.it) at the page devoted to the scholarship information.

## 7.2 Step 2 On-line Interview

Candidates admitted to step 2 will be interviewed by the Committee of Expert, who will evaluate their technical skills, competence on the subject as well as their mastering of the English language. Interviews will be graded on a scale of 40 points.

Interviews will take place starting from 25<sup>th</sup> May 2021 and will be held on-line.

Candidates will be notified by email about the date and time of the interview.

Candidates are requested to come to the interview with the Refugee Identity Card or the PoR card used during the on-line application.

## 7.3 Establishment and approval of the final ranking list

Candidates who will score less than 50/80 points will not be included in the final ranking.

Candidate rankings are drawn up by the Committee of Experts summing up the results of the two phases and are approved by Rectoral Decree. The ranking is organised in decreasing order of points.

For equal points, preference will be given to the younger candidate.

## ART.8 Award and acceptance of the scholarship

Winners will be notified by email by 25<sup>th</sup> June 2021, and the final ranking will be published on the website [www.unimi.it](http://www.unimi.it) at the page devoted to the scholarship information.

In order to confirm the scholarship candidates must reply to the University communication by ten days. Failing to provide a feedback by the given deadline will cause the loss of the benefits.





**By accepting the scholarship, the student fully accepts without reserve UNICORE 3.0 project support and financial benefits at the conditions established in this call for applications.** With the acceptance students also confirm under their own full responsibility that they do not fall within any of the conditions of incompatibility established in article 3 of this call for applications.

## **ART.9 Ranking scroll and assignment of available seats**

In case a candidate winner of the scholarship will officially withdraw by 15<sup>th</sup> July 2021 the scholarship will be allocated to the next eligible candidate in the ranking.

In case of vacant seats, the University of Milan reserve the right to search for eligible candidates from ranking of other University partners. Eligible candidates from external rankings must meet specific requirement of the programmes of University of Milan.

## **ART.10 Renewal**

### **10.1 Renewal requirements**

In order to renew the scholarship students are required to earn **30 university credits** (CFU) by the 10<sup>th</sup> of August 2022.

In case the study plan of the first year of the Master in which the student is enrolled will be of less of 60 credits, the minimum credits required for the renewal will be the half of the full amount of credits for the first year as indicated in the official study plan.

In order to maintain the scholarship, students are required to earn 60 university credits by the 10<sup>th</sup> of August 2023.

Students are required to graduate by the last session available for their matriculation year, e.g. April 2024.

### **10.2 Additional Renewals**

Students who do not succeed to graduate within April 2024 can request a 6 months extension of the scholarship, at the condition to have earned at least 80 university credits by 31 March 2024. Extension request must be submitted to the International Student Office.

## **ART.11 Withdrawal from the course**

Candidates who will withdraw from the program during their studies will lose all the benefits of the scholarship.





**ART. 12 Information notice concerning data processing**

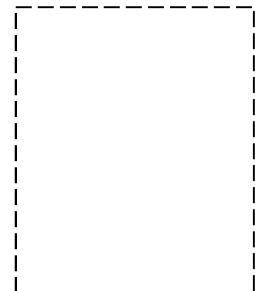
