EU-Passworld is an education pathway enabling talented refugees to develop their skills and careers. Three leading Irish universities are offering highly motivated refugee candidates the opportunity to pursue a full-time, fully funded one year Master's degree with the support of UNHCR and Nasc:

- University of Galway (2 places)
- University College Dublin (2 places)
- University College Cork (1 place)

The five successful candidates will begin their studies in September 2024.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- ✓ Be registered as a refugee with UNHCR and currently reside in Uganda
- ✓ Completed a Bachelor's degree in a field related to Masters programme
- ✓ Achieved minimum GPA equivalent to a 2.2 (Second Class Honours)*
- ✓ Demonstrate appropriate competence in English
- ✓ Be self-reliant and suitable for integration in Ireland as an individual
